#### June 17 – Depart USA

#### June 18 – Arrive in Stockholm

Arrive in Stockholm today. Time permitting enjoy a panoramic tour of the city on your way to the pier. Embark on the Azamara Quest this afternoon and prepare to journey through the Baltic Capitals of Europe.

#### June 19 – Tallinn, Estonia

Walk through the medieval maze that is Old Town Tallinn on your tour today. Drive past ancient ramparts and soaring towers into Upper Old Town. Then, continue on foot up Toompea Hill to Palace Square, where the baroque fortress of Toompea Castle still dominates the city. Follow narrow ways to reach the Russian Orthodox Nevsky Cathedral. A short walk from here lies St. Mary's Cathedral, a gothic masterpiece also known as the Dome Church. Enjoy an inside visit before continuing to a panoramic viewpoint overlooking the rustic medieval rooftops of Lower Old Town. Stroll to Town Hall Square, home to the oldest surviving Town Hall in the Baltic countries. Shop among the many local merchants and stop for coffee and pastries at a local café before a short drive takes you back to the port.

#### June 20 – St. Petersburg, Russia

Rise early to enjoy a scenic cruise along the city's waterways, passing magnificent palaces, sumptuous mansions, and stunning cathedrals. Then, visit the Yusupov Palace, one of Europe's most lavish estates. Explore the estate's grand halls, view its art collection, and learn about the 1916 palace murder of Grigori Rasputin. Then, journey to the famous St. Isaac's Square in the heart of the city. St. Isaac's Cathedral was designed by the French architect Auguste Montferrand and features a vast and opulent interior. Afterward, savor lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a visit to the famous Hermitage Museum. The museum boasts the world's largest painting collection. Finish your thrilling day of discovery with a visit to the beautiful Church of the Resurrection of the Spilled Blood, a traditional Russian-style multicolored onion-domed church.

#### June 21 – St. Petersburg, Russia

On your second day in the city, visit both Pushkin and Peterhof. Your day begins with a visit to the Catherine Palace in Pushkin. Wander through the palace's grand halls and discover the stunning Amber Room, once named the "Eighth wonder of the world." Step outside and stroll the palace's lush gardens, boasting 1400 acres and pavilions surrounding a central lake. Then, sit back and relax over a traditional Russian lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a journey to the Peterhof. The Peterhof is known for its breathtaking fountains, cascades, gardens, and intricate footbridges. Enjoy a scenic drive across the Neva River to visit Vasilyevsky Island. Admire the island's rostral columns and explore the 18th century Peter and Paul's Fortress, the revered burial site of the Russian Tsars.

#### June 22 – St. Petersburg, Russia (On Own)

Spend your on own day luxuriating onboard the Azamara Quest or purchase a shore excursion\* from Azamara today to see more of St. Petersburg.

*You will not be able to disembark the ship unless you purchase an excursion. Cruise Guests are not allowed to enter Russia unless they are on an escorted tour.*

#### June 23 – Helsinki, Finland

Begin your adventure with a drive along the harbor, getting a glimpse of the fleet of Finnish icebreakers. Continue along down the famous Mannerheim Street, snapping photos of Parliament House, the National Museum, and Finlandia Hall, Helsinki's opera and concert venue designed by legendary architect Alvar Aalto. View the Olympic Stadium which hosted the games in 1952 and then stroll the serene and lush grounds of Sibelius Park. Marvel at the monument dedicated to the Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. Then, step foot inside the stunning Tempeliahukko Rock Church, a one-of-a-kind church blasted out of solid rock. Finally, journey to Senate Square where you can snap photos before returning to the ship.

#### June 24 – Helsinki, Finland (On Own)

Spend your on own day luxuriating onboard the Azamara Quest or purchase a shore excursion\* from Azamara today to see more of Helsinki.

*\*You will be able to disembark the ship if you do not purchase an excursion and explore Helsinki on your own.*

#### June 25 – Mariehamn, Åland, Finland (On Own)

Spend your on own day luxuriating onboard the Azamara Quest or purchase a shore excursion\* from Azamara today to see Mariehamn. The capital of Åland, Mariehamn was named by Alexander II after the Empress Maria, and its broad streets lined with linden trees recall its Russian heritage. Nowadays it's a bustling, touristy place – home to parks, museums, restaurants, shops, galleries and more.

#### June 26 – Return Home

This morning your ship returns to Stockholm. Transfer to the airport for your return flight home. *Some guests may have to overnight in the New York area and return to their home city on June 27.*

**June 14 – Depart USA**

**June 15 – Arrive in Oslo**

Arrive at Gardermoen Airport in Oslo and transfer to your hotel in central Oslo. If you arrive early, we suggest buying an Oslo Pass for free travel on all public transit along with free admission to over 30 museums and attractions plus special offers on entertainment, restaurants, shops and more. The pass can be purchased at tourist information centres or at most hotels and major attractions in the city.

**June 16 – Norwegian Fjords**

Get an early start to Oslo Central Station for the start of your scenic journey on the Bergen Railway. This train ride, voted as one of the best in the world, takes you over the “mountainous rooftop” of Norway and through charming villages like Gol and Geilo on your way towards Bergen. At Myrdal, switch to the Flåm Railway for an incredible 20 km ride with a 900-metre descent to the beautiful town of Flåm. Here, you have about 45 minutes of free time, which you may wish to use by learning about the history of the world’s steepest train line at the Flåm Railway Documentation Centre. From Flåm, continue by boat through the Aurlandsfjord and into the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Nærøfjord, the narrowest fjord in Europe. This is perhaps the most beautiful part of the Sognefjord with its mighty waterfalls and small farms clinging to the steep mountainsides. At Gudvangen, a bus takes you through the magnificent Nærøy Valley to Voss, the connection point for the final train ride to Bergen. Spend the night at a hotel in Bergen.

**June 17 – Bergen**

Spend the first half of the day as you wish in Bergen. Though this is Norway’s second largest city, it still has the charming atmosphere of a small town. Here you’ll find the old wharf of Bryggen—a UNESCO World Heritage site, along with well preserved old houses, the vibrant fish and flower market, the Fløibanen funicular with great views and many museums. In the afternoon, make your way to the central station for your return train ride to Oslo, where you’ll spend the night.

**June 18 – Depart Oslo & Arrive in Stockholm**

Depart Oslo this morning and arrive in Stockholm this afternoon. Time permitting enjoy a panoramic tour of the city on your way to the pier.

**June 20 – St. Petersburg**

Explore St. Petersburg’s rich history, culture, and unique treasures on this grand journey through the heart of this iconic city. See Palace Square, cross the Neva River, and view the magnificent rostral columns of the Spit of Vasilievsky Island, passing Peter and Paul’s Fortress. Then, enjoy a guided tour of the Winter Palace. In the Old Hermitage, you’ll view a splendid collection of Italian Renaissance masters, including paintings by Leonardo da Vinci and Rafael. After a delightful lunch at a local restaurant, you’ll visit the iconic Russian masterpiece - the Church of the Spilled Blood.

**June 21 – Moscow**

Board Russia’s “Sapsan” train and zoom to bustling Moscow. Visit Red Square and gaze out at the onion-shaped domes of St. Basil Cathedral. Embark on an interior tour of the Kremlin. Explore the Armory Chamber, home to court regalia, golden carriages and priceless Faberge Eggs. Stroll into Cathedral Square. Enter the Archangel Michael Cathedral, once the private chapel of Russian Czars. Leaving the Kremlin, take a ride on the Moscow Metro. Created during the Stalin era, its opulence is more palatial than public transportation. Marble, mosaics and grand chandeliers abound at every turn. During your tour, you will be invited to have lunch in one of the top Moscow restaurants.

**June 22 – St. Petersburg**

Journey to the “Town of the Tsars” and enter a realm of palaces, fountains and gardens that once served as the summer home of Russian royalty. Begin with a drive through St. Petersburg past historic landmarks. Upon arrival in Peterhof, head to the Grand Palace of Peter the Great for a guided exploration. Stroll among the Lower Gardens, a 300-acre park replete with fountains and offering panoramic views of the Gulf of Finland. Leave the ghosts of the past behind and head to the pier where a state-of-the-art hydrofoil is waiting. Climb aboard for an adrenaline-pumping voyage back to St. Petersburg. Take in one last view of the Grand Palace looking back from the water and bid farewell to the summer home of Russian tsars.

### PASSPORT INFORMATION:

Discrepancies in information or failure to check in for your tour may result in change fees, delays in receiving travel documents for your trip, or denial of travel.
