# Holy Land via Jordan

## *The Trip of a Lifetime!*

### **March 4-5 – USA to Amman, Jordan**

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart on your international flight. You will be welcomed to **Amman, Jordan** by our representative and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### **March 6 – Petra**

Travel south from Amman for a visit to the city of **Petra**. Its entrance passes through a long, narrow gorge known as the **Siq** and can only be accessed by carriage, horseback or on foot. Once inside the city, marvel at the intricate detail of a city that was cut into the cliff sides of rose-colored rock. Return to Amman for overnight.

### **March 7 – Mount Nebo, Madaba, Qumran & Jericho**

Visit **Mount Nebo**, where Moses caught a glimpse of the Promised Land (Deuteronomy 34). On a clear day, you can see all the way across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea, to the rooftops of Jerusalem and Bethlehem. Continue to **Madaba**, the City of Mosaics, to visit the **Church of Saint George** with its sixth-century, Byzantine, mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites. Cross the border into Israel and visit **Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scrolls discovery**. Learn about the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Time-permitting, experience the mineral-laden waters of the **Dead Sea** before heading to **Jericho** to visit the ruins of the ancient city Joshua conquered (Joshua 6:20). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the **Temptation of Jesus** (Matthew 4:1).

### **March 8 – Ein Karem, Bethlehem & the Herodion**

Travel to **Ein Karem**, where Mary visited with Elizabeth. In **Bethlehem**, visit the cave where Jesus was born (Luke 2:1-7) and see the **Church of the Nativity** built over the site. Gaze out over **Shepherds' Field**, where the angels first proclaimed the Good News, and conclude your day by exploring the **Herodion**, the palace-fortress of Herod the Great.

### **March 9 – Jerusalem**

Enter the **Old City** and walk along the **Cardo**, the ancient main street. The **Southern Wall Excavations** of the Temple Mount, including the **Teaching Steps** and the **Western Wall**, are a must see. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5:1-18), where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne** to experience its beautiful acoustics. Visit Herod's **Antonia Fortress**,

where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross," and end your day at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, reflecting on Christ's sacrificial love.

### **March 10 – Jerusalem**

Stand on the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did, and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Visit the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus prayed for God's will to be done (Matthew 26:36-39). Visit the **Upper Room**, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14:12-26). Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas** (Matthew 26:57), where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. End your day with communion at the **Garden Tomb** (Matthew 27:57-60).

### **March 11 – Caesarea, Megiddo, Nazareth & Cana**

Visit the **Roman Aqueduct** and **Theatre at Caesarea**, a center of the early Christians, where Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10), and where Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for trial. Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo**, where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Journey to **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23), and recall Jesus' first miracle as you travel through **Cana** (John 2:1).

### **March 12 – The Galilee**

Enjoy a scenic drive to **Capernaum**, center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee (Matt. 4:13, 23). On the **Mount of Beatitudes**, contemplate the text of the Sermon on the Mount that Jesus preached there (Matt. 5-7). Experience a special onboard worship service as you **sail across the Sea of Galilee**. Visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** in **Tabgha**, the traditional location of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10-17). As you pray in the Chapel of the Primacy, remember how Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ three times (John 21). In **Magdala**, once home to Mary Magdalene, visit a recently discovered first-century synagogue.

**March 13 - Return from Amman to the USA or enjoy a Cruise on the Nile.**



- March 13** Today you will fly across the Sinai Peninsula and the Suez Canal to the city of Cairo, Egypt. Check into your hotel in Cairo for dinner and overnight.
- March 14** Admire ancient treasures at the Egyptian Museum. Visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. Overnight in Cairo.
- March 15** Fly to Luxor and embark your Nile cruise ship before lunch. This afternoon cross to the east bank of the Nile to visit the Luxor and Karnak temples.
- March 16** Today you will cross to the west side of the Nile and explore the Valleys of the Kings & Queens. See the Colossi of Memnon, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the Necropolis of Thebes. Cross through the Nile locks on your way to Edfu.
- March 17** Visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu before sailing to Kom Ombo to visit the Temple there shared by the gods Sobok & Haroeris.
- March 18** Disembark the boat today in Aswan. See the Temple of Philae, the High Dam of Aswan, the Granite Quarry and the Unfinished Obelisk. Fly to Cairo for dinner and overnight.
- March 19** Depart Egypt this morning and arrive in the US.

**REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED AFTER 11/19/18:**

We welcome registrations after 11/19/18. Registrations received between 11/20/18 - 12/4/18 will incur a \$100 per person fee. Registrations received between 12/5/18 - 12/19/18 days prior will incur a \$200 per person fee. Registrations received after 12/19/18 will incur an additional fee based on air availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is coverable.
